Deliverable 4.4 Raising Local Cuisine: 10+10 Recipes Based on Local Wine Varieties, Producing 3000 Bottles of Dionysos Wine

Results:

10 (GR) + 10 (BG) recipes related to local cuisine and local grapevine wine varieties. Production of bottles of wine "Dionysos" by a Greek partner and assistance from Bulgarian partners with wine and recommendations. "Dionysos" wine is intended for local stakeholders, restaurants, hotels, events and more.

Partners involved:

Institute of Viticulture and Enology, Pleven, (Partner 2); Faculty of Economics and Social Sciences, University of Plovdiv "Paisii Hilendarski" (Partner 3); Kavala Development Agency (Partner4), Federation of Professional, Crafts and Trade Associations of Evros (Partner 5)

Schedule:

From November 2018 to March 2019

Who does what:

Institute of Viticulture and Enology, Pleven, (Partner 2) and Federation of Professional, Crafts and Trade Associations of Evros (Partner 5) produce the common wine of the project (Dionysos).

Common protocol:

During the joint working meetings between the Bulgarian and Greek partners, a decision was made and agreed for the production of wine "Dionysos". The following was agreed:

1. The wine that will be bottled will be from wines produced from more widespread and economically important grapevine varieties.;
2. The wine should be made and mixed (blended) of wines from Bulgaria and Greece.
3. The wine should be produced from wineries from the cross-border region of Bulgaria and Greece, falling within the area of the DIONYSOS project.
4. The wine should be red dry.
4. To propose and select wine samples in advance, then to taste and evaluate their characteristics and authenticity by specialists.
5. Bulgarian wine is sent to Partner 5, who prepares, bottles and labels it.
6. Before bottling and presenting for consumption, partners must approve a bottle and appropriate label.
7. The wine should be presented at events to promote the DIONYSOS project and the cross-border region of Bulgaria and Greece.

Implementation:

1. Haskovo Chamber of Commerce and Industry (HTCC, Partner 8) provided to the Institute of Viticulture and Enology-Pleven (IVE-Pleven) samples of red dry wines produced by wine enterprises in the Haskovo district.

2. A panel of experts tasted and evaluated the characteristics of the wine samples provided, and then issued a written opinion to the HTCC (Partner 8).

3. Commission approves "Dionysos" wine bottles and labels proposed by Greek partners.
